However, other tissues like corneas, heart valves, skin bones etc can be donated in natural death. Organ like Kidney, Liver can also be donated by living donor. One can be an organ donor by signing a donor card from any hospital and NGO. If a person has a donor card, it means that he/she is willing to donate organs upon death. We should remember that in our country even if one has signed the donor card, it is important to have the consensus of the family while signing the donor card. The donor card should be kept by everyone in his wallet as a proof of his/her wish to donate organs upon death. Dr
